Castlecomer in 1921.	Show on Saturday morning, Mr. O'Connor recalled recent guest, Professor Arthur Brooks', advice to "go back" to Catholicism if he wanted to be happy. "Remember Arthur Brooks there about a month ago, who is a happiness expert, who I think a lot of people got a lot out of? So I said to him afterwards, what's the secret? What's the one thing?, 'Are you a Catholic?' And I said, 'In name and everything,' and he said, 'Go back," Mr. O'Connor told his listeners. "And I said, 'Seriously? And he said' Go back', he said, 'Everything that all the science shows us, that the one thing that people who are truly happy have is faith/religion." Speaking to this paper in June, Professor Brooks said that faith plays a crucial role in living a happy life. There's a lot of research on the main happiness habits but faith and life philosophy are the first factors to be considered, Professor Brooks told The Irish Catholic newspaper then "I was rattled by it, to be honest," Mr. O'Connor said. "I've been wrestling since with it, but anyway, that was his, as a scientist, that was his one big thing."
