#### WORK IN THE CHURCH

The work on the upper level of the façade will be completed very shortly. Removing the pointing has been a slow and pain stacking task but necessary: the concrete has been replaced by lime and this will ensure that water is not sealed in the stone of the church which causes problems in the plasterwork in the interior as is evident behind the organ in the gallery. Contact has been made with the architect about the recent damage to the sanctuary ceiling and

plans are being put in place to repair this damage.

Please exercise caution and refrain from unnecessary entry to the sanctuary area. Your understanding at this time is appreciated.
