## ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI (FEAST 4TH OCTOBER)

Saint Francis of Assisi is perhaps the most known and loved saint within the Catholic Church. Though many flock to him because of his portrayal as one who loved animals and nature, he became one of the greatest saints in the history of the world for one simple reason: he was a true servant of the Most High God. The Season of Creation is officially ending on the feast of St. Francis, but care for Earth must be ongoing. Pope Francis encourages us "to reflect on our lifestyles, and how our daily decisions about food, consumption, transportation, use of water, energy and many other material goods, can often be thoughtless and harmful."

#### SYNOD 2023 ROME

The synod is the result of a two-year process that started in September 2021, when the Vatican released a preparatory document and instructions on how to prepare for the summit. Catholic faithful around the world then met in their parishes to discuss the questions posed by the synod. The syntheses of those conversations were then sent to their respective bishops' conferences.

The Bishops then sent their conclusions to the Vatican, where a group of some 30 experts, theologians and pastoral workers met in the town of Frascati near Rome in September 2022 to draft a document that would guide the next phase. This document, entitled 'Enlarge the Space of your Tent' was sent to the back to the bishop's throughout the world for further reflection. Their reflections have become another document, Insturmentum Laboris, that will guide discussions at the upcoming synod.
