## **Church Renovation**

The present phase of work has concluded this week. Under the instruction of Mr Michael O'Boyle Tallis Builders have carried out remedial work to the sanctuary ceiling. On assessment there was more work to be undertaken. Four areas were identified that had to be replaced and this has now been done. In other areas of the sanctuary the decorative plasterwork required stabilising by tying back the plasterwork to the wooden batons and this has also been done.

The next phase will be undertaken in the New Year when a specialised painter will be employed to paint the ceiling. This work will require a tower of scaffolding to be erected. Hopefully we can now return to the use of the church as normal for daily mass and other services. Thanks to all for their understanding and ongoing support in recent weeks.
