Work in the Church

Repair work to the ceiling of the sanctuary will commence on Monday 6th. This work will be in two phase. Phase 1 will be the assessment of the damage and plaster repair. It is estimated that this will take two weeks – though this timescale is dependent upon the examination of the ceiling. Phase 2 will be done in the New Year; the plaster will need to dry out before a specialist painter will come to repaint the ceiling. The work is estimated to cost between $\[\in \] 20,000 \]$ and $\[\in \] 25,000 \]$. Unfortunately this is a cost that we the parish will have to carry.

With the cooperation of the builder we can use the church for 9am mass each morning though not at the main altar. A temporary altar will be used half way down the church. For health and safety reasons the upper part of the church will not be accessible. All other celebrations and prayer gathers will not be possible during these two weeks. Webcam transmission will be limited though we hope that the parish radio will continue to be available for those who use it.

Synod '24 - The Church begins to dream...

The document released at the conclusion of the first of the two-part climax to the Synod process points toward a profound shake-up of the Church. Its proposals include an expanded role for women in ministry, making lay involvement in decision-making mandatory, an overhaul of the seminary system, and a revision of the Church's Code of Canon Law. While the Synod did not deal with the most contested topics in the Church this was the first round of a synod double-header, which began at the local level two years ago. "Today, we do not see the full fruit of this process, but with farsightedness, we look to the horizon opening up before us," Pope Francis said in his homily at the Mass in St Peter's Basilica concluding the assembly

The breakthrough achieved by the Synod was not to be found in the texts focusing on particular issues, but in the widespread acceptance of the ways of discussing and discerning that were adopted at this Synod for the first time.

The second and concluding session of the Synod on Synodality will be held in the Vatican in 11 months' time. It will be vital for the realisation of Francis' "dream" that the work continues and the momentum created by the first session is sustained. But the synodal and missionary Church is already emerging.
