Week of Christian Unity 2024

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity takes place each year from the 18 to 25 January. This special week provides an opportunity to focus our prayers on Christian unity, as well as speak about and experience Christian unity personally, in our village, town or county. This year the theme 'You shall love the Lord your God... and your neighbour as vourself' (Lk 10:27) has come from an ecumenical team from Burkina Faso – each year the theme is chosen by a different country. It is from the scene of the Good Samaritan in the Gospel of Luke. Jesus stresses the connection between love of God and love of neighbour with a particular concern for challenging the boundaries of who is considered "neighbour". Jesus invites us to observe the commandments and to also imitate the love of God in the giving of self for another.

Pope Francis Jubilee Year 2025

Pope Francis is looking ahead to the Jubilee Year 2025 as "a pilgrim of hope". In the Christmas Day *Urbi et Orbi* message Pope Francis mentioned the jubilee and expressed the hope that 2024 would be "a time of preparation for the Holy Year" and "an opportunity for the conversion of hearts, for the rejection of war and the embrace of peace, and for joyfully responding to the Lord's call." In 2023 the Vatican launched the Jubilee website which lets people choose proposed pilgrimages and other various events.
