## Word of God Sunday

A Sunday designated to the Word of God was instituted by Pope Francis on 30 September 2019. The motto this year is taken from the Gospel of John: "Remain in my Word" (John 8:31).

Archbishop Farrell, Archbishop of Dublin, points out that Pope Francis is highlighting the importance of Sacred Scripture in the life, worship, and mission of the Church. The Bible is not the preserve of the few. It belongs to all of us. It is the book of the people of God. It is a rich source for prayer, for contemplation and consolation.

Archbishop Farrell emphasises that Scripture is at the centre of everything the Church does. "The Scriptures nourish and shape our prayer and our worship. They help us understand our world. They shape our world view. They teach us how to live and relate to each other. They continually call and challenge us to permit the Word of God to take flesh in our lives."
