Vocation's Sunday

Today is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. It is also known as 'Good Shepherd Sunday' because the Gospel is always from John chapter 10 where Jesus speaks of himself as being a caring shepherd. The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfil the Lord's instruction when he asked us: "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). A whole year has been dedicated to prayer and promotion of the vocation to the diocesan priesthood. The theme of the year was entitled 'TAKE THE RISK FOR CHRIST'. Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood and religious life and the Church will always having pastors who care for God's people with the heart of Christ himself. There will be a Holy Hour in St Fiacre's Church Loughboy, on Tuesday 23rd April, 2024. This time of prayer is organised by Fr Mark Condon, Ossory Vocations Director. All welcome.

Master's Winners Speaks of his Faith

Scottie Scheffler won the 2024 US Masters last Sunday – his second win. Since World War II only Tiger Woods, Jack Nicklaus and Seve Ballesteros have won two Masters by age of 27; Scheffler, who is 25, now joins that short list. Reflecting on the role of golf in his life, Scheffler took the interview in a religious direction, saying his faith is his defining trait. "I'm a faithful guy. I believe in a creator. I believe in Jesus... I feel like I've been given a platform to compete and show my talent. It's not anything that I did".

He added that his focus is on working hard and praising God, not chasing fame. "I've been called to come out here, do my best, compete and glorify God," Scheffler said. Following his success on Sunday he commented "It's a pretty special feeling to know that I'm secure for forever," he said. "I believe that today's plans were already laid out many years ago, and I could do nothing to mess up those plans."
