

Sacred Space (www.sacredspace.ie) is a service provided by the Irish Jesuits. Begun in 1999 it has grown into a global online apostolate for daily prayer since that time and now offers prayer in approximately 15 languages. They offer daily prayer on their site as a guide through to prayer in six stages, including preparing your body and mind, and culminating in reflection on the Gospel of the day according to the Roman Catholic liturgical calendar.

Each week Something to Think and Pray About This Week is provided on the home page. This is normally an excerpt taken from a book on Ignatian spirituality. Please note that Sacred Space is also published annually in paperback and is available in the Cathedral Bookshop at St Mary's Cathedral.
