JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE 2025: HOPE IN THE LORD

Bishop Coll will celebrate the closing Mass of the Jubilee in the Diocese of Ossory in St Mary's Cathedral at 5.30 p.m. on this Sunday. Pope Leo XIV will celebrate the Closing Mass for the Jubilee Year in St Peter's Square on the 6th January.

EPIPHANY – MARKING THE DOOR 20+C+M+B+26

A tradition around the 6th of January is the writing of a special sign in chalk over the front door, as a reminder of the visit of the Magi – the three wise men. The doorpost of the house is marked with an inscription of the new year separated by C+M+B. In 2026 the inscription will be 20+C+M+B+26.

C+M+B stands for the Latin words *Christus Mansionem Benedicat*, which means "May Christ bless this house." The letters also stand for the traditional names of the Magi who visited Christ: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar.

(gather at the door and after marking the threshold with chalk pray the following prayer)

God of Light, bless this home.

Make it a haven of rest

for all in need of your warmth and care.

And when we go out from this place,

may we never lose sight of the Epiphany star.

May all who enter throughout the year

find love and light for Christ has come

to dwell in this home

and in our hearts.

May we be like the Maji

and always look for you in our lives.

Be with us, protect us and guide us.

Help us to always show your love

to one another and to all in need.
