WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, from 18 to 25 January 2026, marks this annual occasion for prayer, reflection and dialogue on the journey towards that unity which Christ himself prayed (John 17:21-23), with the theme: 'There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling' (Ephesians 4:4). The resources for the 2026 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity have been themed and written by the Armenian Apostolic Church, which is recognized as one of the world's oldest Christian communities. Pope Francis in 2024 reminded us that prayer must hold a preeminent place in efforts to restore unity to the Christian church. "As we pray together," he went on, "may we acknowledge, each of us starting with himself or herself, our need for conversion, for letting the Lord change our hearts. This is the path before us: journeying together and serving together, giving priority of place to prayer".

OSSORY DIOCESE BECOMES VACANT

The See of Ossory will become "vacant" (known in Latin as "Sede Vacante") when Bishop Coll takes up his appointment in Raphoe next Sunday, 24th January.

It is expected that the Holy See, through the offices of the Papal Nuncio, will announce an Apostolic Administrator to administer the diocese during the interregnum. No major decisions or changes can be made by the Diocesan Administrator while the See of Ossory is vacant, since Church Law forbids him from doing anything which could in any way prejudice the Diocese, or the rights of the new Bishop.
