WORD OF GOD SUNDAY

Each year, the Church sets aside a special Sunday to celebrate the Word of God. Known as Sunday of the Word of God, it invites us to reflect more deeply on Sacred Scripture and to renew our love for God's Word. It takes place this Sunday (25 January).

Pope Francis in 2019 chose the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time so that, each year, the whole Church could focus together on the Bible and its central place in our faith.

The Sunday reminds us that in Scripture God is speaking to us today. When the Word of God is proclaimed at Mass, Christ himself is present and addresses his people. This Sunday reminds us that listening to God's Word is essential to knowing Jesus and living as his disciples.

THE DIOCESE OF OSSORY – WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

The Papal Nuncio, Archbishop Luis Mariano Montemayor, will now begin the process to appoint a Bishop of Ossory. In a recent visit to Kilkenny to meet the College of Consultors of the Diocese the Archbishop informed us that he was mandated by Pope Francis, on his appointment to Ireland, to continue a rationalisation of the Church in Ireland, particularly the number of dioceses in Ireland. Since the Council of Ráth Breasail in 1111 there were 26 dioceses in Ireland. This process has already taken place in the west of Ireland: Elpin and Achonry, Tuam and Killala, Galway and Clonfert are not administered by the same bishop. Each diocese remains a distinct entity, each with its own history, territory and identity - they are united under the pastoral leadership of a single bishop in *in persona episcopi*.
