ANNUAL CROAGH PATRICK CLIMB 7 FEB 2026

Well done to all who braved the weather and the hill to climb *Cruach Phádraig* this weekend. A pyramid shaped peak that overlooks Clew Bay this important pilgrimage site rises 764 metres (2,507 feet) over the village of Murrisk. While Reek Sunday, the last Sunday in July, is the traditional day to climb the reek, earlier in the year has become Castlecomer Weekend for the past 14 years. While it is traditionally called the Reek the Irish name *Cruach Phádraig* means St Patrick's Stack.
