In accordance with Church Law (Canon Law) Bishop Coll had appointed seven priests of the diocese to the College of Consultor in 2024. The group has a defined role in Canon Law. Bishop Nash has proposed that this group would continue as an advisory group during the interregnum meeting with him on a regular basis.

FEAST OF ST BRIGID – FEBRUARY 1ST

St Brigid is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. She was born c454. When she was young her father wished to make a very suitable marriage for her but she insisted in consecrating her life to God. She received the veil and spiritual formation from St Mel and stayed for a period under his direction in Ardagh. Others followed her example and this led her to found a double monastery in Kildare with the assistance of Bishop Conleth. She died on February 1st and is buried in Downpatrick, with the other patrons of Ireland, Patrick and Columba.
